

## POTATO AGRA

<b>Quality specification</b>	
<b>Deliverable grades</b>	Potato of 3797 variety, with matured and thick skin, stored in cold storage (farm-fresh potatoes not allowed for delivery), free of common scab & blight, confirming to the following standards
<b>Colour Grade</b>	
Acceptable upto	Fair and Bright Skin
Rejected	Proportion of dark and dull potatoes exceed more than 10%.
<b>Size</b>	
Acceptable size (measured from at least one side by way of passing through sieve)	4cm – 8 cm
Rejected	If Below 4cm and above 8 cm exceeds 15%
<b>Cut potato (cuts measuring &gt; 1 cm long, &gt; 2 mm deep, &gt; 2 mm wide)</b>	
Acceptable upto	3% maximum
Rejected	Above 3%
<b>Green potato</b>	
Basis	3%
Acceptable	Upto 4%, with discount of 1:1 for above 3% & upto 4%
Rejected	Above 4%
<b>Black scurf (chitri / makhi) on the surface area</b>	
Acceptable upto	6% maximum. Above 4% and upto 6% with discount of 1:1.
Rejected	Above 6%
<b>Rotten and dry potato</b>	<b><u>For Entire season:</u></b>
Basis	1%
Acceptable	Upto 2%, with discount of 1:1 above 1% & upto 2%
Rejected	Above 2% %
<b>Damaged skin / Bruised potato</b>	
Basis	3% maximum
Acceptable	Upto 6%, with discount of 1:1 for above 3% & upto 6%

Rejected	Above 6%
<b>Shrivelled potato</b>	
Acceptable upto	4% maximum
Rejected	Above 4%
<b>Potato sprouts more than 5 mm:</b>	
<b>For March to June</b>	
Acceptable upto	3% maximum
Rejected	Above 3%
<b>For July onwards</b>	
Acceptable upto	6% maximum
Rejected	Above 6%
<b>Physical impurity in the form of soil and stone:</b>	
Basis	0.50%
Acceptable	0.5% -- 2% With rebate 1:1
Rejected	Above 2%
<b>Frost bitten Potato (Hyper cooled potato from cold storages)</b>	
Basis	Nil
Acceptable	Upto 0.25% with discount of 1:1
Rejected	Above 0.25%
Cumulative deformities in case of Cut, Green, Black scurf, Shrivelled and Sprouts should be maximum 13% from March to June and from July to October, it should be maximum 15%
