Dear Members,

New VSAT Technology

In terms of the provisions of Rules, Bye-Laws and Business Rules of the Exchange, Members are notified as under:

MCX has decided to deploy new VSAT technology which gives better performance in terms of very low downtime due to fault tolerant, redundant, faster with high throughput and automatic switchover of hub components.

The revised terms and conditions relating to VSAT usage are as under:

- 1. Commercial charges:** VSAT charges will be Rs. 1.65 lakh. Any member placing an order for VSAT will be required to pay Rs. 1.65 lakh (Rupees one lakh sixty five thousand only) by way of a demand draft favoring 'Multi Commodity Exchange of India Limited'. This would include cost of:

- i. Site survey
- ii. Installation
- iii. Transportation
- iv. Commissioning of VSAT equipment (ODU, IDU and Antenna)
- v. Cost of the IFL cable (up to 100 feet)

However, sales tax, octroi and entry tax, if any, will be payable on actual basis by the member separately in addition to cost of extra cable, if any.

- 2. Recurring Charges:** The recurring charges towards Broadcast and Interactive Bandwidth, Annual Maintenance Charges, charges of DoT and WPC etc. for 3 years from the date of installation of the respective VSAT are included in the above commercial charges. After completion of 3 years from the date of installation of respective VSAT, the members would be required to pay annual maintenance charges, broadcast and interactive bandwidth charges, taxes and other levies along with charges of DoT and WPC as decided by the Exchange.

- **Terms relating to existing VSAT users:** The terms for migrating to the new Skyedge VSAT technology for the existing VSAT user members shall be intimated separately.
- The terms for surrender of VSAT equipment and shifting charges will remain the same as mentioned in the circular no. MCX/020/2004 dated April 15, 2004 issued earlier.

Members are requested to take note of it.
